# PRACTICAL INFORMATION (1/2)



## Language

In Paris, people speaks French language. Concerning the English, they have a little more difficulties. However parisian students have a better knowledge of English language and could help you if you are in need.

#### Currency

In France, the official currency is EUROS (€). You can get money from a ATM or pay by card. Please note that the credit card could be used almost everywhere, but be aware in somes taxis or small shops, you could only pay by cash. It is good to have 10-20 € in cash with you, just in case.

## **Public Transport**

In Paris, the public transport is managed by RATP and SNCF. From the 5th of December, RATP and SNCF took part to the national strike. The public transport is very affected and a lot of buses/metros/RER could be canceled! If you can, we advise you to choose to travel by foot.

#### **Ticket Price:**

- One way ticket t+ (for Metro, Bus, Tram, RER): 1,90€.



- From the aeroport CDG to City center: 10,30€.

At the metro station you could also buy a ticket for several days/weeks. You can buy tickets in any metro station. You have also the possibility to buy (only) **BUS TICKET** from the driver for the price of **2€**.

# PRACTICAL INFORMATION (2/2)

## **Telephone**

In France, numbers have 10 digits and begin with 01 (for the Paris region). Mobile numbers start with 06 or 07.

If you want to call from abroad (or from a non French phone) to a French number: Before putting the French number you should compose the international code oo followed by 33 (for France), then you can put the number **without the first o!** 

Exemple: You want to call 01 23 45 67 89 => 00 33 1 23 45 67 89.


